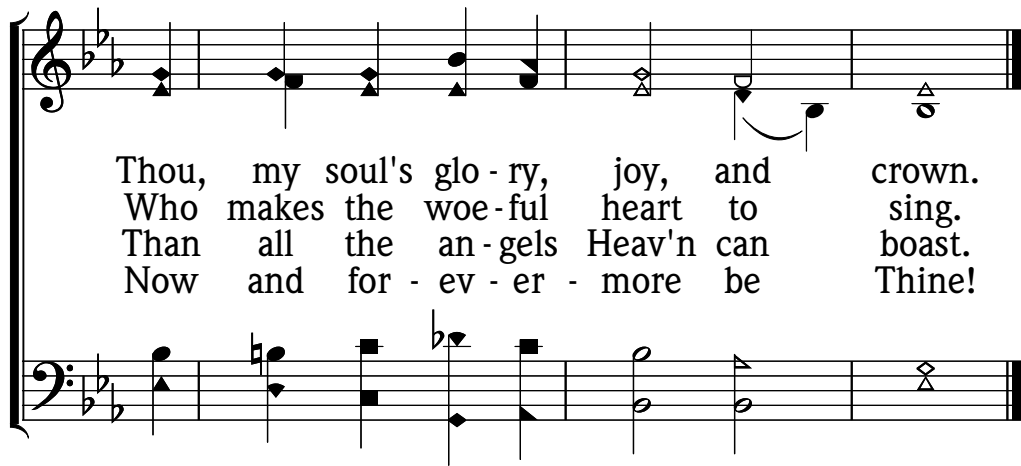


O Thou of God and man the Son!
