






1. Lean on the might - y arm of Je - sus, Hide in the hol - low of His hand;

4. Lean on the might - y arm of Je - sus, And of His bound - less mer - cy share;




'Neath His pro - tect - ing wings a - bide you, Firm on the Rock of A - ges stand.
